

# ***Striking Back***

## **At the Propaganda Mill of the Animal Prohibitionists *Preventing the Cuckolding of Americans and Meltdown of Animal Ownership in the U.S.***

When the penalty for violation of a minor animal offense (e.g., exceeding some artificial pet number limit or rigid animal husbandry requirement) can result in thousands of dollars in fines, seizure of all animals, jail time, liens on personal property, crucifixion in press releases (usually provided by an “animal prohibition” organization), and general grinding of individuals into the dirt for \*daring\* to raise animals—then common sense tells us that there’s something going on that is unsavory and unacceptable in our society.
